

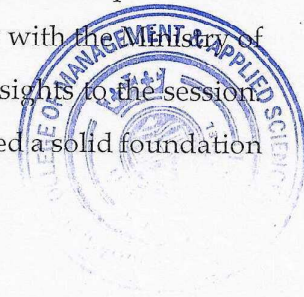
Report: Seminar on GST Insights for Entrepreneurship

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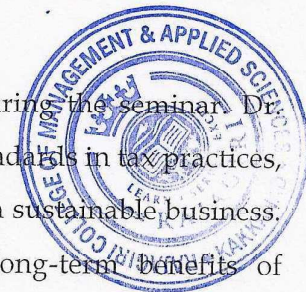
for an in-depth exploration of GST regulations and their impact on business operations.

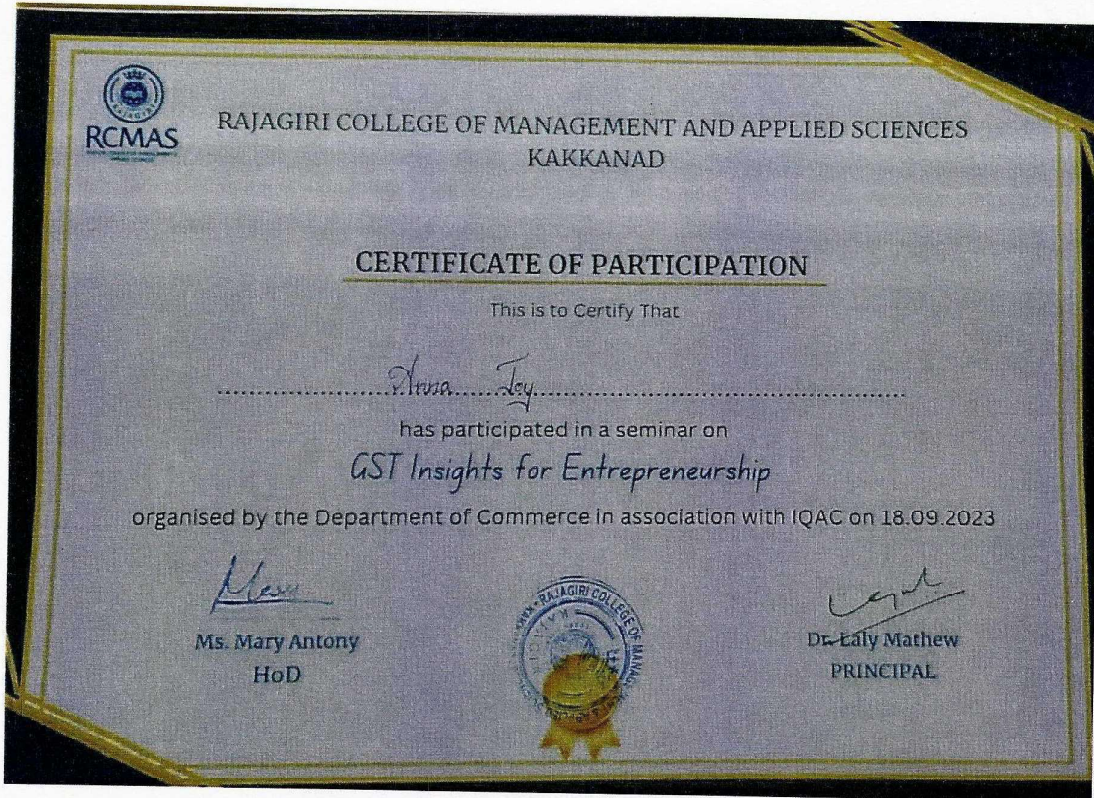


