Annual Report for the Academic Year 2019-2020

Rajagiri Clege of Management and Applied Sciences, established in 2005 by the CMI Fathers of the Sacred Heart Province, is affiliated with Mahatma Gandhi University. RCMAS offers one postgraduate programme and ten undergraduate programmes across various fields.

INFRASTRUCTURE

The college features six floors with 36 lecture halls, various specialized labs (2D, 3D, Stop-Motion, Audio-Visual), a mini-seminar hall, a stationery and souvenir shop, an auditorium, a library, a chapel, and a functioning canteen. Most classrooms are equipped with Smart Class Technology, and surveillance cameras in the sixth floor and a digital attendance system enhance exam security and record-keeping. The campus is fully CCTV-enabled for security, and an inter-departmental intercom facilitates faculty communication.

The fully automated college library houses 10,442 books and subscribes to 17 regional and national periodicals. Library hours are scheduled to encourage student use of the facility.

The college boasts an outdoor gym, two basketball courts, a cricket pitch, football ground, netball court, tennis court, volleyball court, kabaddi area (256 square meters), and an indoor table tennis area. Sports training is provided by Dr. BipinDas U.R.

The Guidance Cell, led by Ms. Sangeetha Jose, effectively helps students and faculty manage emotional challenges

ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

We aim to provide a conducive learning environment for student self-actualization. Our multidisciplinary approach develops employable skills and evaluates academic achievements. In-Semester Assessments, seminars, and assignments help track and grade overall performance. The college offers 9 certificate courses outside the regular curriculum to equip students with a competitive edge in the job market.

Remedial sessions, for students who need them, are available daily from 3:30 pm to 4:30 pm and on the first and third Saturdays from 9 am to 12 pm.

Classes for the academic year began on 10 June 2019 for sixth semester students, 12 June 2019 for fourth semester students, and 24 June 2019 for first semester students.
