## **COLLEGE ANNUAL REPORT - ACADEMIC YEAR 2020-2021**

Education must include developing a humane ideal. RCMAS follows the motto “Learn, Serve, Excel” to enhance students' knowledge while building moral, social, and rational foundations. The college aims to empower and uplift young minds to lead the future.

The past year brought significant challenges, especially in education, due to COVID. RCMAS had to adapt to virtual learning, acquiring new technological skills but sacrificing the dynamic, in-person campus experience. Despite these changes, the college faced the challenges with grace, optimism, and dedication.

Rajagiri College of Management and Applied Sciences, established in 2005 by the CMI fathers of the Sacred Heart Province, is affiliated with Mahatma Gandhi University. It offers ten undergraduate programs in fields such as Commerce, Management, Computer Science, Animation, and English, and recently added two postgraduate courses in Commerce and Graphic Design. In addition to the regular curriculum, 12 Certificate Courses are offered in the college.

This year the college welcomed Rev. Fr. Dr. Mathew Vattathara CMI as the Director and Rev. Fr. Ajeesh Puthussery as the Principal.

Rev. Fr. A. J. Saviance CMI, after 6 years of dedicated service, bid farewell. His vision and hard work were crucial in shaping the college's success.

### **INFRASTRUCTURE**

The college features a six-floor building with 36 lecture halls, modern computer labs, a 2D lab, 3D lab, Stop-Motion lab, mini seminar hall, stationery and souvenir shops, an auditorium, library, chapel, and a functioning canteen. Most classrooms are equipped with Smart Class Technology. Surveillance cameras are installed on the sixth floor and in the auditorium for exam security, and the campus is fully CCTV-enabled for vigilance and security. An inter-departmental intercom system supports faculty communication.

The fully automated college library holds 10,985 books and subscribes to 17 regional and national periodicals. Library hours are scheduled to encourage maximum student use.

The campus features an outdoor gym, indoor and open basketball courts, a cricket pitch, football ground, netball court, tennis court, volleyball court, kabaddi area with a 256-square-meter Asian Federation standard mat, an indoor table tennis area, and an open auditorium. Intensive sports training is provided by Dr. Bipin Das U.R.

## ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

We aim to create a learning environment that supports students' self-actualization. Our multidisciplinary approach fosters employable skills while evaluating academic achievements through In-Semester Assessments, seminars, and assignment.

The classes for this academic year commenced on 01 June 2020 for the sixth semester students, on 24 June 2019 for the fourth semester students and on 22 October 2020 for the first semester students.

## **DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND SPORTS CLUB**
