COLLEGE ANNUAL REPORT - ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023

The Father of our Nation always reminded us of an “Education for life, through life and throughout life.” Education is concerned essentially with future and future has no hope without education. At Rajagiri, we aim at an education that can enable, ennoble and empower the moral, physical and psychological moorings of the student community, in the phase of growing skepticism and eroding traditions and values.

Rajagiri College of Management and Applied Sciences 10 undergraduate programmes in Commerce, Management, Computer Science, Animation, and English. We also offer two postgraduate courses in Commerce and Graphic Design. Fifteen certificate courses and one diploma course are offered outside the regular curriculum. This academic year has six MoU’s initiated by various departments and the IQAC.

As part of fostering our international alliance and collaboration with reputed foreign universities, our college was visited by two esteemed Universities abroad.
