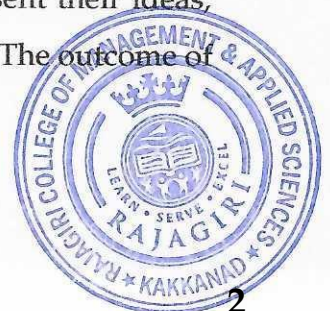
**Innovation Workshops:** Hands-on sessions on design thinking, prototyping, and business model canvas.
