





Anti-Ragging and Ethics Committee

per Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009, UGC has imed regulations in order to prohibit, prevent, and eliminate the scourge of gging. In pursuance to the Judgment of the Honble Supreme Court of India dated 08.05.2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (g) of sub-section (1) of section 26 of the University Grants Comission Act, 1956, the UGC notified "Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Raging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009". These regulations are mandatory or all universities/institutions.

What Constitutes Ragging?

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

- Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating, or handling with rude ness a fresher or any other student.
- indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psycho logical harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any ther student.
- Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- iny act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts, or disturbs the regular

- academic activity of any other student or a fresher.

 Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the services of a fresher or any other students for completing the services of the any individual or a group of students.
- Exploiting the services or a nestret or any order to completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students. Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a free transfer or the students.
- Any act of manical extension of a fine or any other student by students.

 Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it; sexual abuse, homo sexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causin bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
- Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which wor also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other
- Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or Any act that affects the mithout an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority, or superiority by a student over any fresher.

Punishment Provisions:

Any student or group of students found guilty of ragging on campus or campus shall be liable to one or more of the following punishments:

- Debarring from appearing in any sessional test/ university examination withholding results Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges

- Withdrawing scholarships and other benefits Suspension from the college for a period of one month
- Cancellation of admission
 Debarring from representing the institution in any national or internation meet, tournament, youth festival, etc
- Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
- Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 to 4 semester or equivalent period
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution
- Fine up to twenty-five thousand rupees
- Imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years or with fine wh may extend to ten thousand rupees or with both
- Collective punishment When the students committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collect

punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers











