The DEAR event served as a preliminary gathering, setting the tone for the subsequent REACH alumni program, which commenced later in the day.

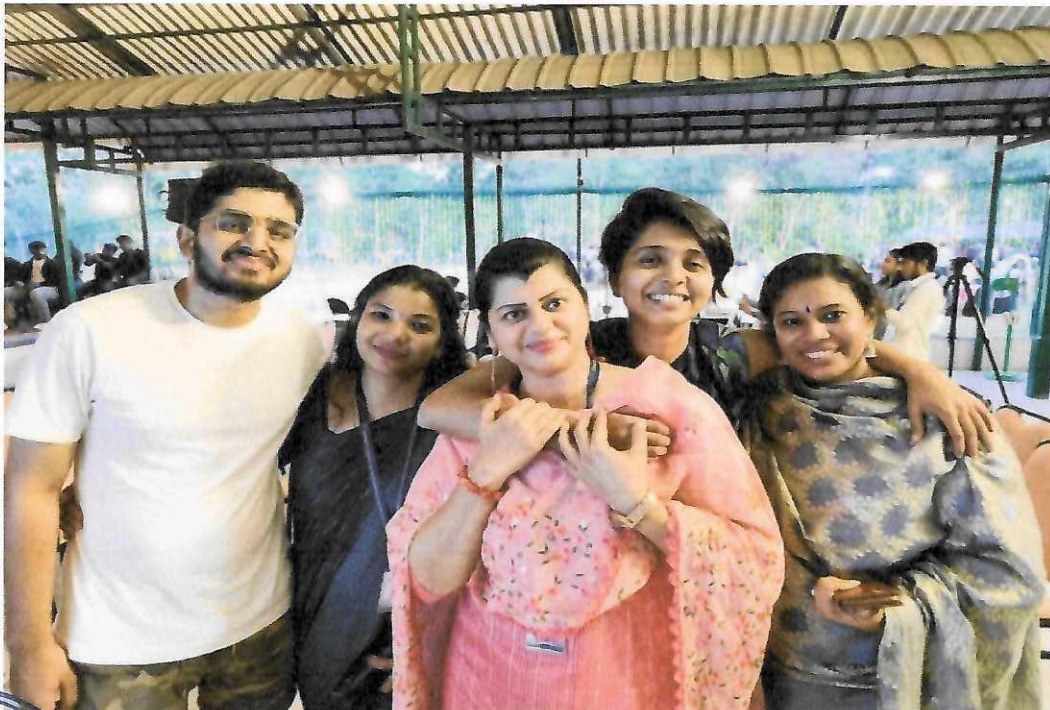

This meeting represents a significant milestone in enhancing the Department of English's alumni network and its continuous collaboration with the college, ensuring sustained support for future endeavors.



- Alumni participation and presence can be also seen from the various placement orientations, entrepreneurial talks and professional programs conducted by the alumni for the students of department of commerce.

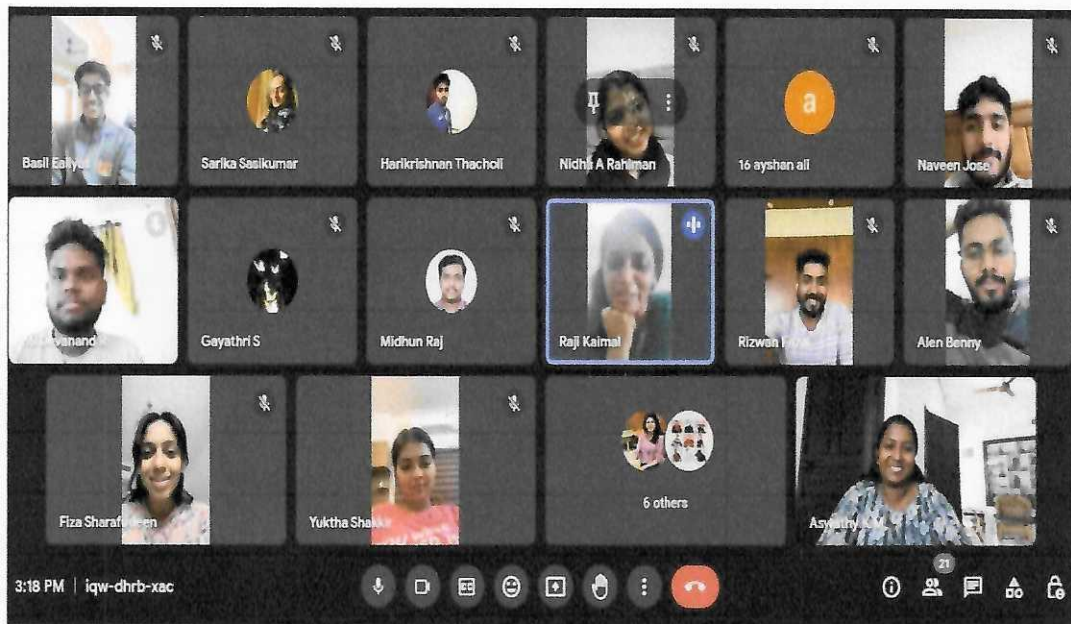
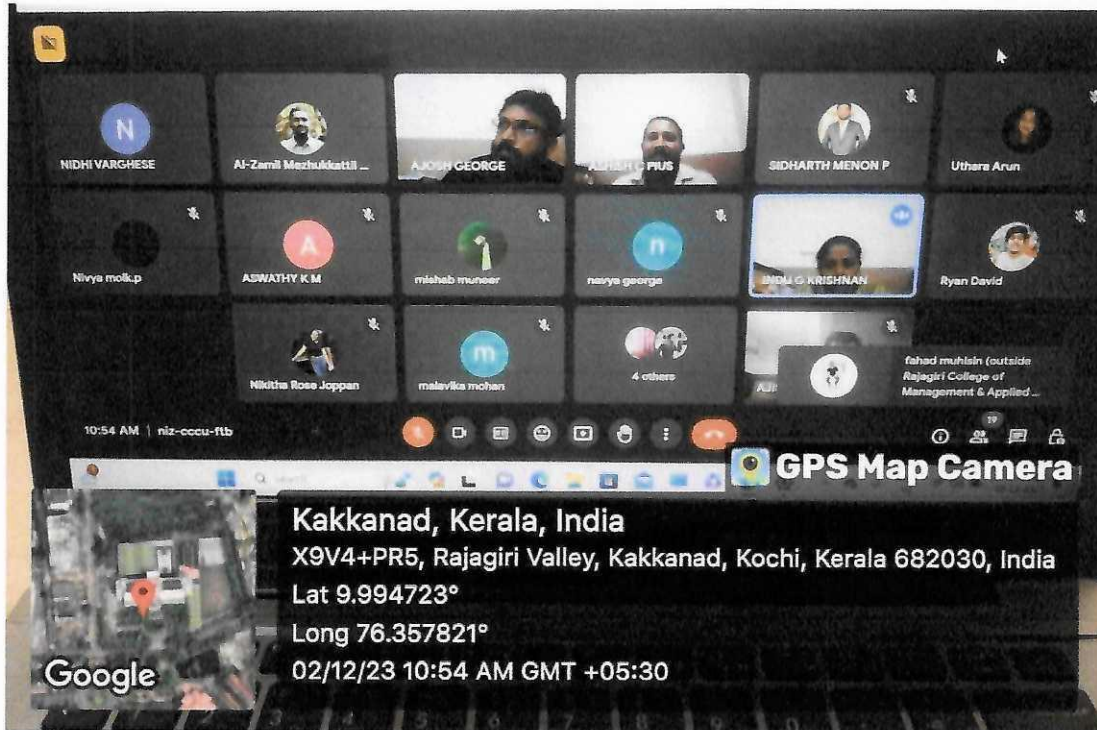

- Alumni were also encouraged for future developments such as partnerships with industry leaders to enrich content and relevance of value-added courses.

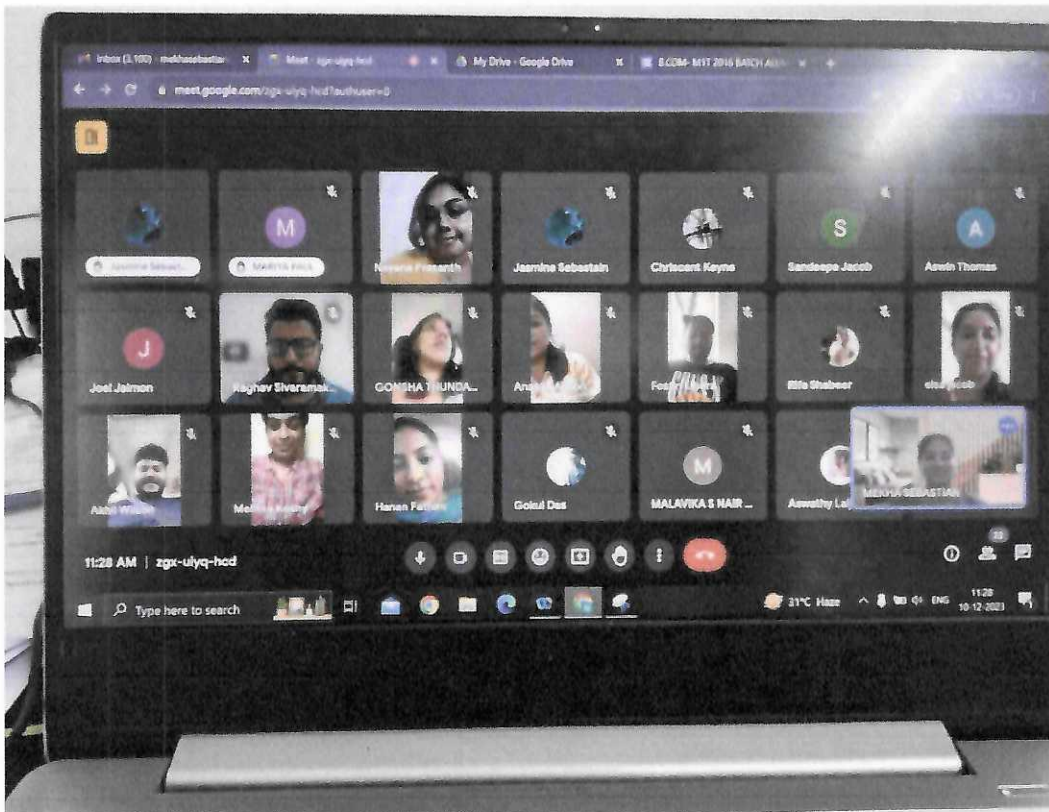
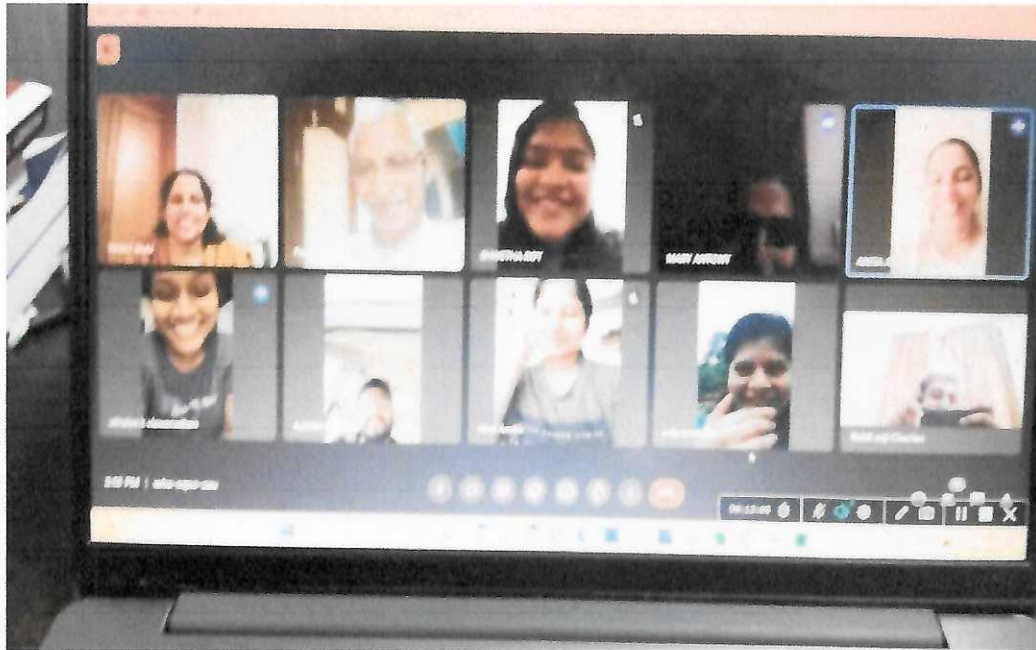

The alumni meet of the Department of Commerce was a successful event fostering connections between faculty and former students of the department.



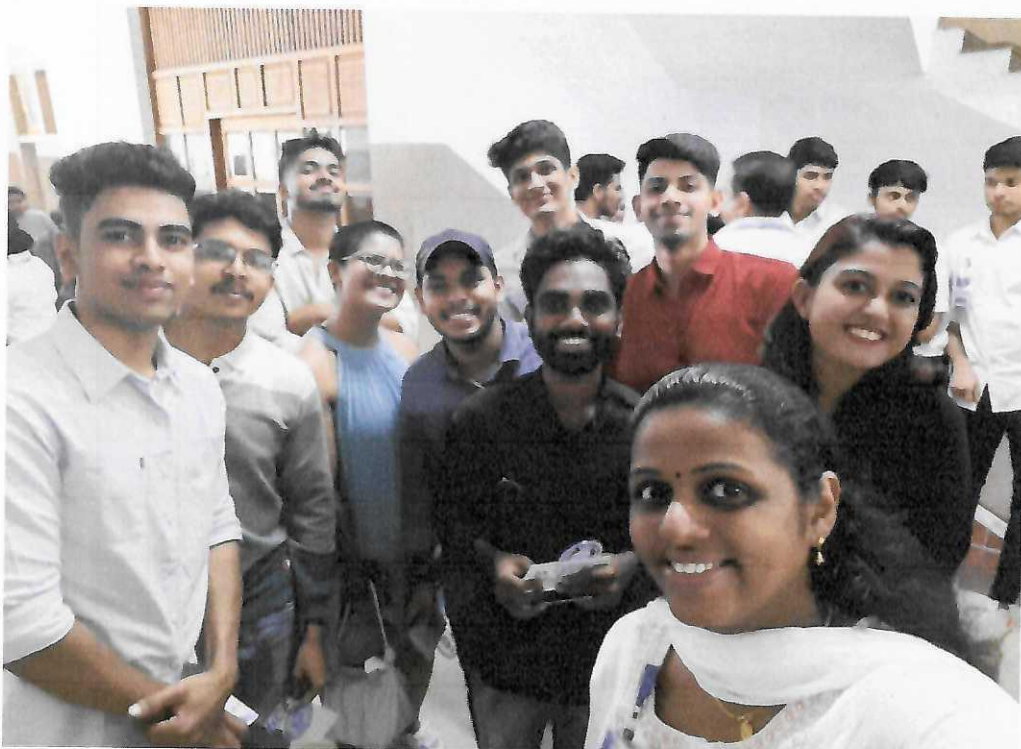
