COLLEGE ANNUAL REPORT - ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-2022

Rajagiri College of Management and Applied Sciences is affiliated with Mahatma Gandhi University, provides 10 undergraduate programmes in Commerce, Management, Computer Science, Animation, and English. We also offer two postgraduate courses in Commerce and Graphic Design. Twelve certificate courses are offered outside the regular curriculum. RCMAS has initiated three MoUs this academic year.

INFRASTRUCTURE

Academic year 2021-22 witnessed several new vicissitudes to the infrastructure.

- A new office for the Director, Board Room and Basketball court with new scoreboard, court bleachers and two brand new hoops were inaugurated.
