## College Union Election





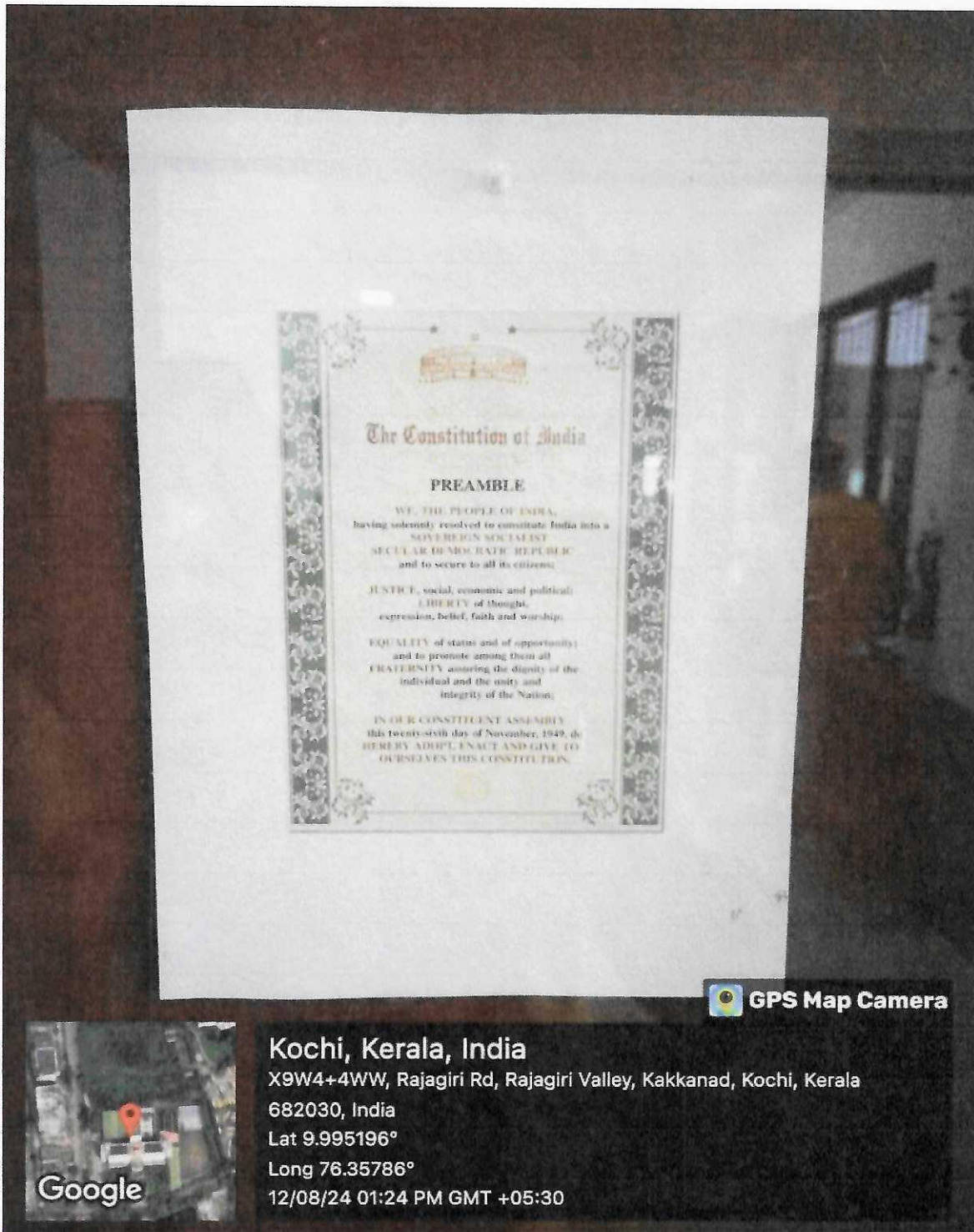
