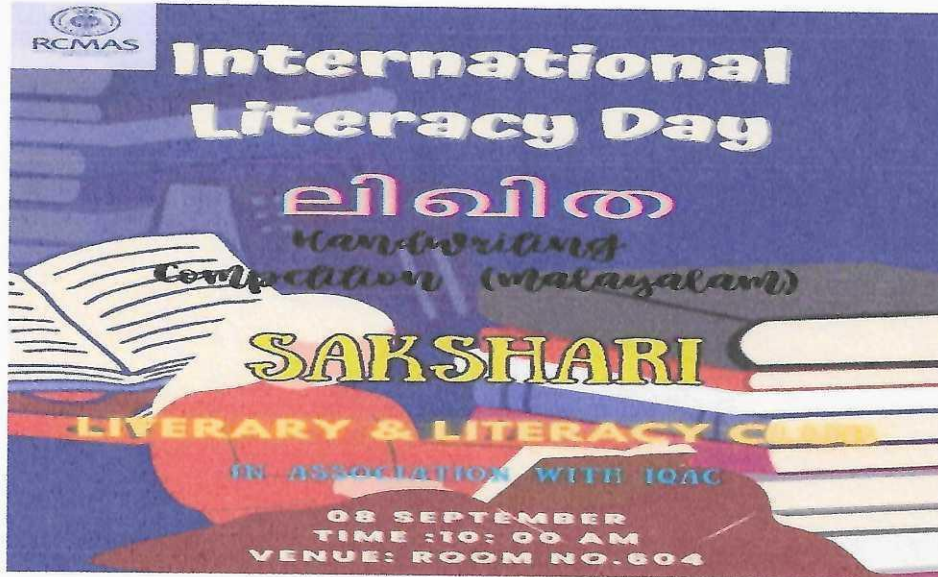



The fest was a resounding success, with participants demonstrating exemplary skills and creativity in each of the game events. The organisers and student



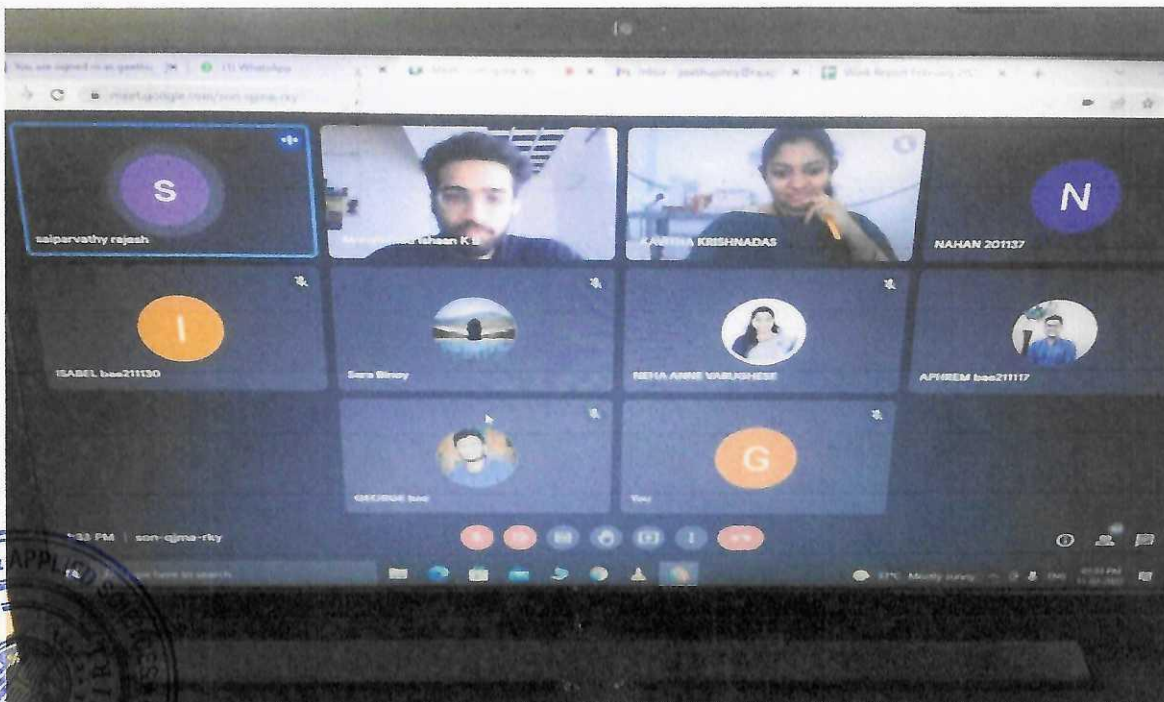

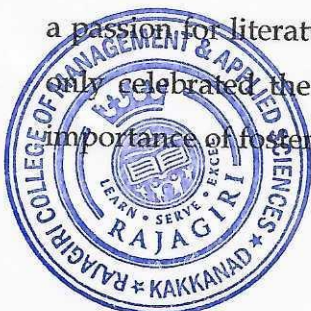
## Report on Solasta 2k19- An Intra-Collegiate Literary Fest



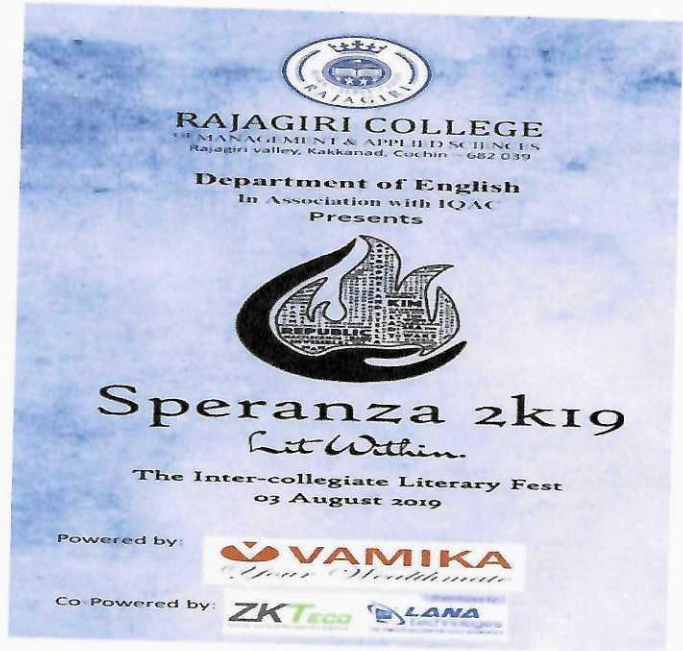
