- Second and final year batch coordinators have been appointed and have started educating students about the consequences of ragging.
- The committee organizes an orientation program specifically focused on anti-ragging awareness for incoming first-year students.
- Differentiated break times for first-year students have been implemented for the first two to three weeks.
