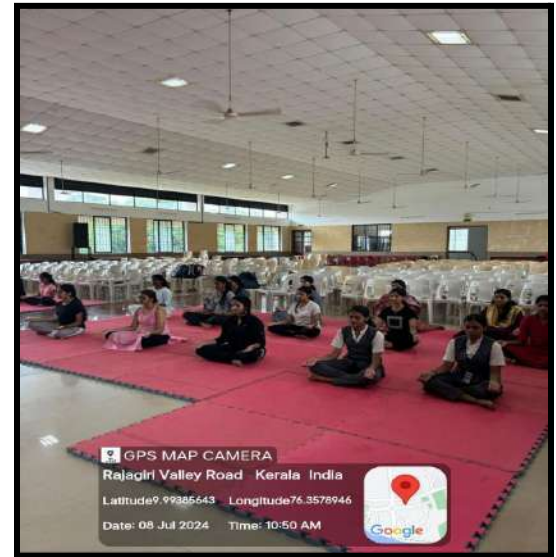

3. Professional Development: Forming Readiness through Campus Environment and Engagements

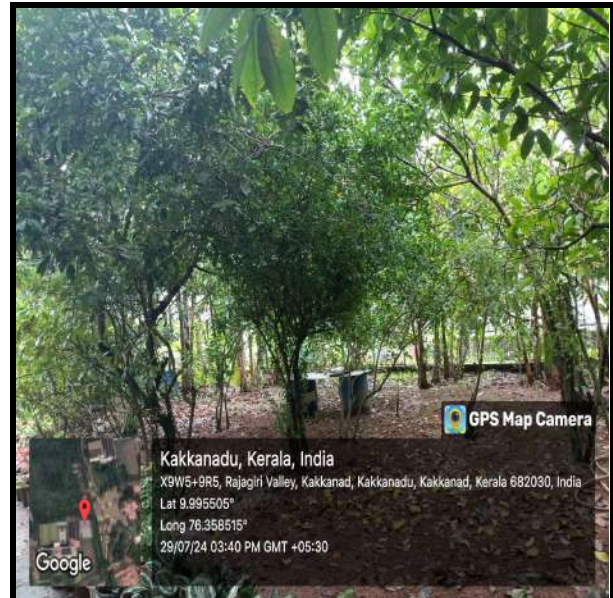
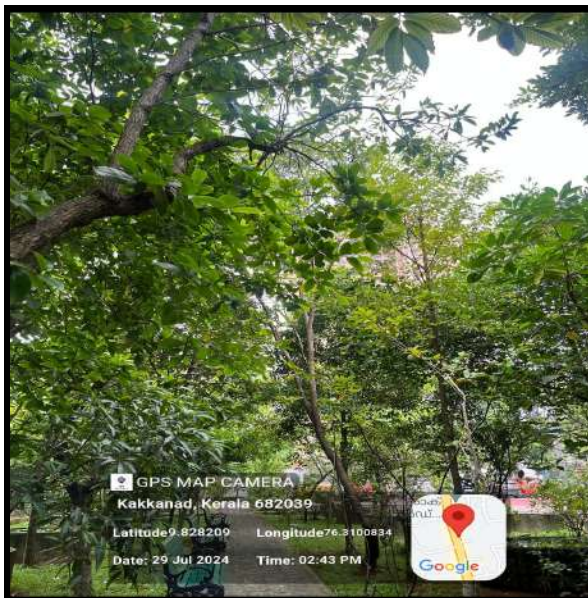



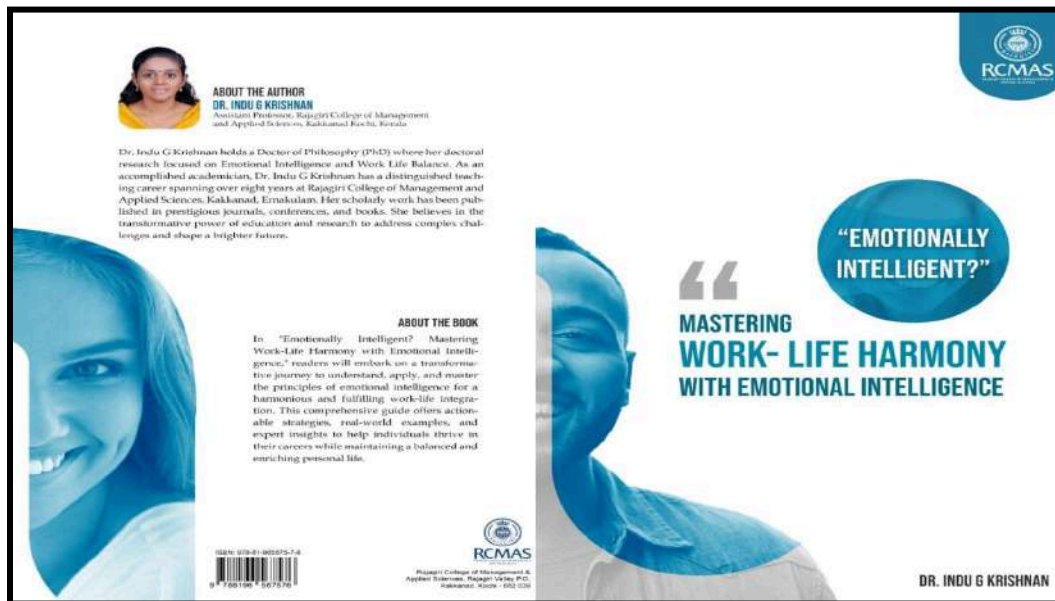


MCampus portal of a Faculty

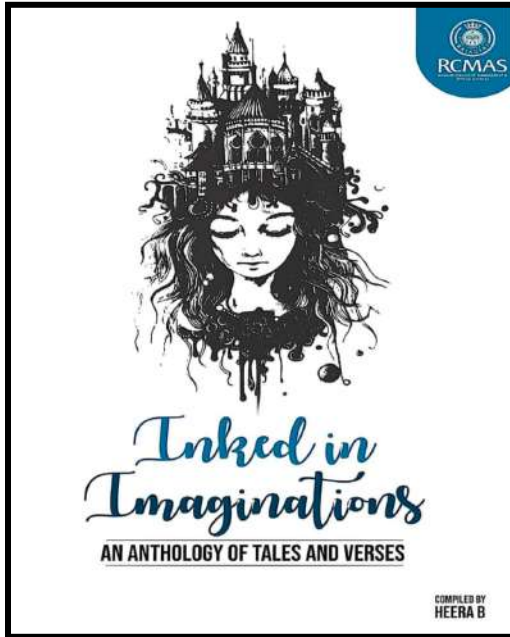

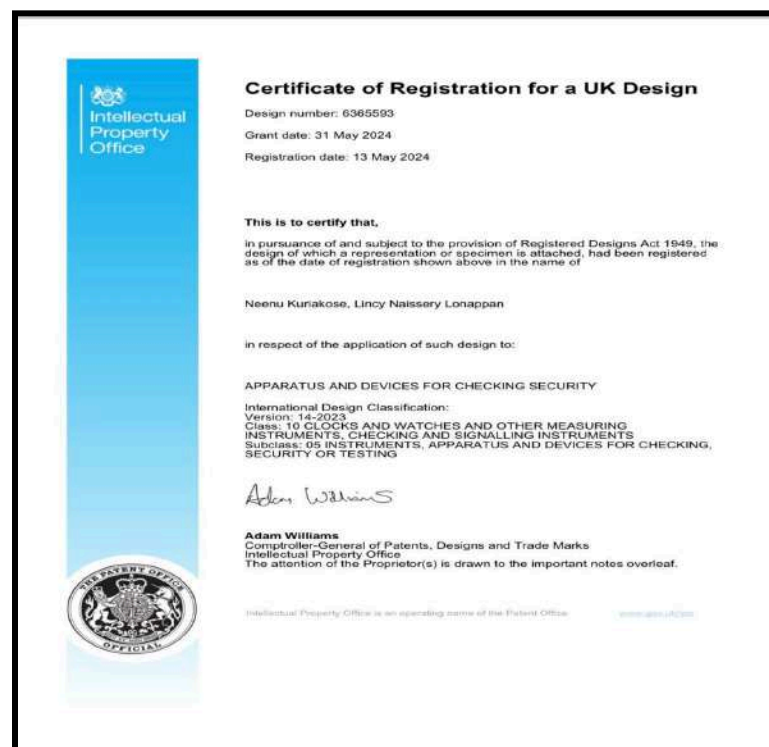
